



Finished Block Size 6" x 6"



Requirements


- ✦ 6 ½" x 6 ½" square for background
- ✦ 5" x 5" square for house appliqué
- ✦ 5" x 5" square for roof, window frames, chimney and door appliques
- ✦ 2" x 4" rectangle for cloud appliqué
- ✦ 4" x 4" square windows appliques
- ✦ 3" x 3" square shrub appliqué.

Block Assembly

1. Trace the house, roof, chimney, shrub, and cloud appliqué shapes onto dull side of fusible web. {Patterns have been reversed for fusible appliqué. Patterns do not include seam allowances for needle turned appliqué.}
2. Cut ⅛" away from drawn line.
3. Fuse the pattern pieces to the wrong side of the fabrics.
4. Cut out applique shapes on drawn line.
5. Remove the paper backing from each shape.
6. Position the pieces on the background square, ensuring that the applique lies within the seam allowance.
7. Fuse all pieces onto the background square. Machine appliqué all pieces in place with a narrow zigzag stitch.
8. Unfinished block size 6 ½" x 6 ½"
