



Requirements


- ✚ Fabric 1 (for the background): 6 ½" x 6 ½" square
- ✚ Fabric 2 (for the center design) : 7" x 7" square
- ✚ Fusible web: 7" x 7"
- ✚ Water soluble pen

Preparation


1. Trace the block outline onto background fabric.

Block Assembly

1. Trace template pieces 1 - 17 on dull side of fusible web.
2. Cut out shapes 1/8" away from edge.
3. Following manufacturer's instructions, fuse the templates shapes to wrong side of fabric 2.
4. Cut out shapes on the drawn line. For the center circle, cut outside the line about 1/16" all around. The circle's edge will cover the raw edge of the surrounding pieces.
5. Peel off the paper backing from all the pieces.
6. Start placing the appliqué pieces in place on the background fabric 1. The last piece should be the center circle.
7. Following manufacturer's instructions, carefully fuse the pieces in place on the background.
8. Appliqué in place using your favourite appliqué stitch and matching thread.
9. Unfinished block size is 6 ½" x 6 ½".




No seam allowance added
