

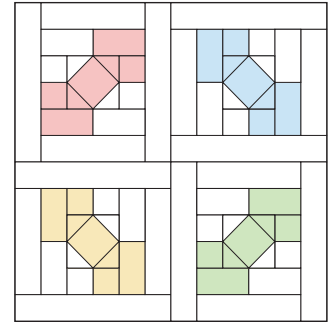
Some techniques in quilting are like learning to tie your shoelaces in a perfect bow. It takes practice, patience and perseverance.

Finished Block Size 6" x 6"



Paper Piecing

Suggested cutting measurements for each Bow.

Background

- ∞ A2, A4 - 1 ½" x 1 ½" cut once on the diagonal
- ∞ B1, C2 - 1 ½" x 1 ½"
- ∞ E1, D2 - 1 ½" x 2"
- ∞ E3, D3 - 1 ½" x 3"
- ∞ F1, G1 - 1 ½" x 4"

Bow

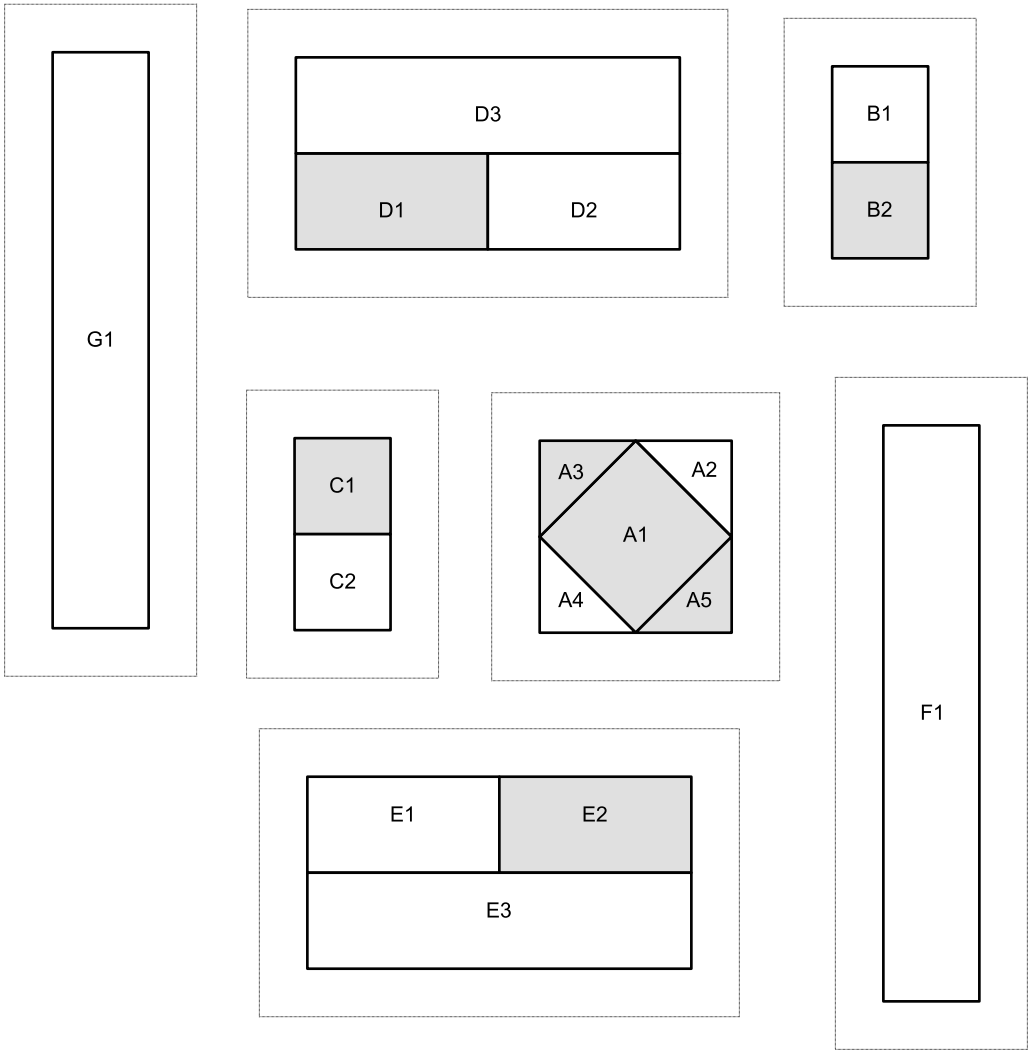
- ∞ A1 - 2" x 2"
- ∞ A3, A5 - 1 ½" x 1 ½" cut once on the diagonal
- ∞ C1, B2 - 1 ½" x 1 ½"
- ∞ D1, E2 - 1 ½" x 2"

Block Assembly

1. Paper piece each bow following the numbering on the paper piecing templates.
2. Join sections.
3. Trim finished block to 6 ½" x 6 ½".
4. Remove papers.

Paper Piecing Template

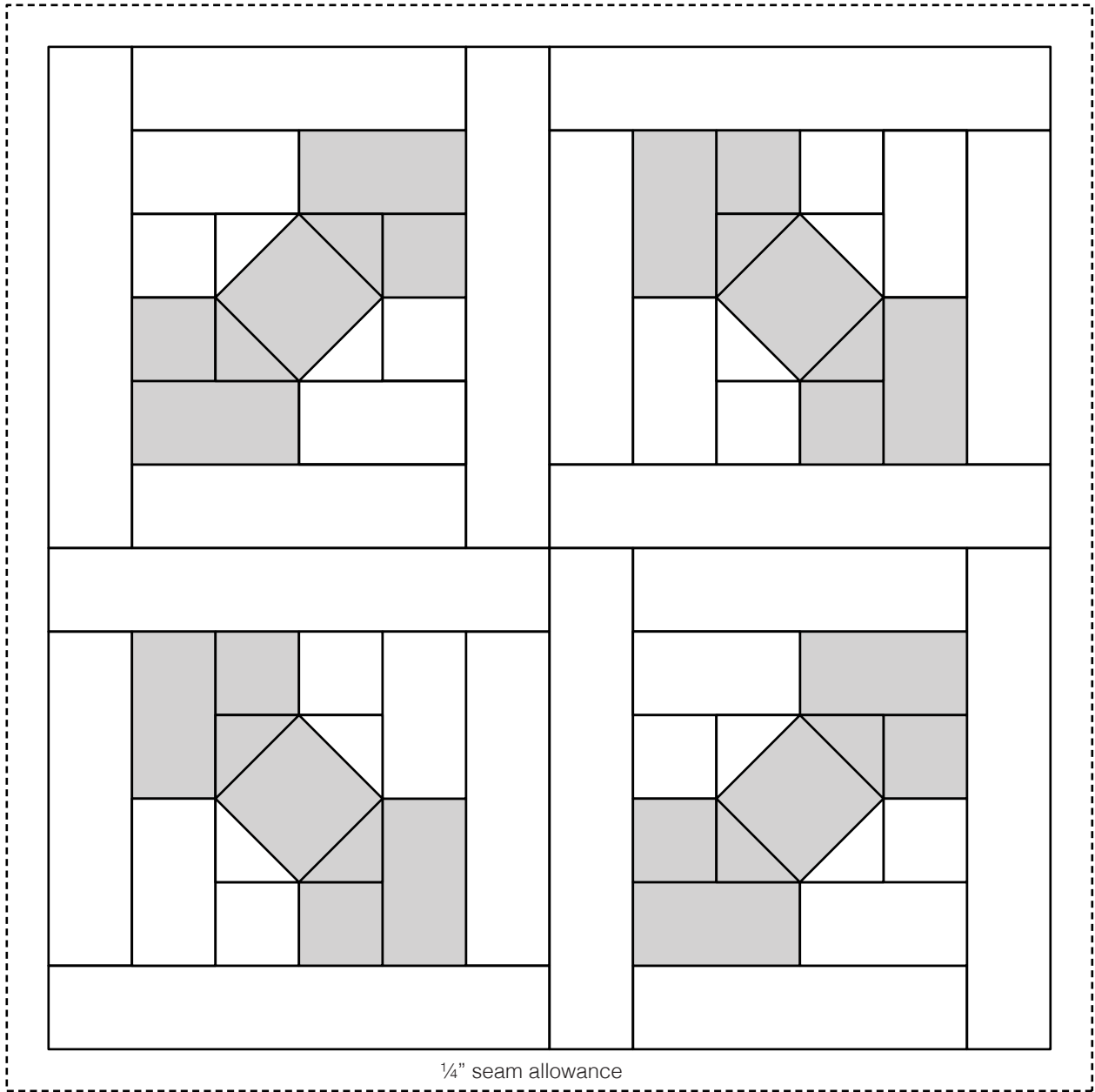
Template in reverse
