

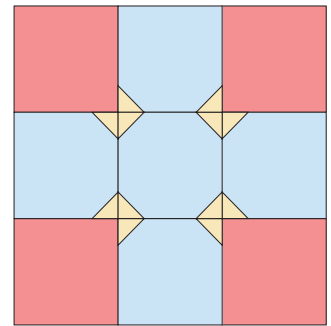

Rising Star

Finished Block Size 6" x 6"



Cutting

From fabric A cut:

✂ 4 squares - 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"

From fabric B cut:

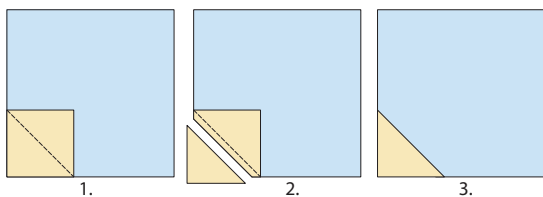
✂ 5 squares - 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"

From fabric C cut:

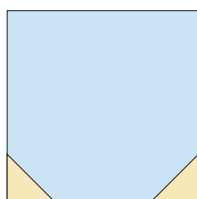
✂ 12 - 1" x 1" squares. Draw a diagonal line on back of each square.

Unit 1

1. Pin a 1" x 1" square (C) on two corners of 4 - 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares (B). Sew on drawn line.
2. Trim excess fabric leaving 1/4" seam allowance.
3. Press corner triangles back.



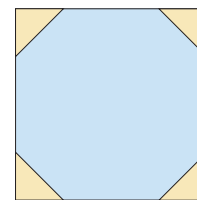
4. Make 4 unit 1.



Unit 2

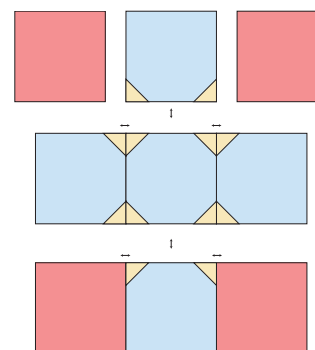
1. Pin a 1" x 1" square (C) on four corners of 1 - 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" square (B). Sew on drawn line.
2. Trim excess fabric leaving 1/4" seam allowance.
3. Press corner triangles back.

4. Make 1 unit 2.



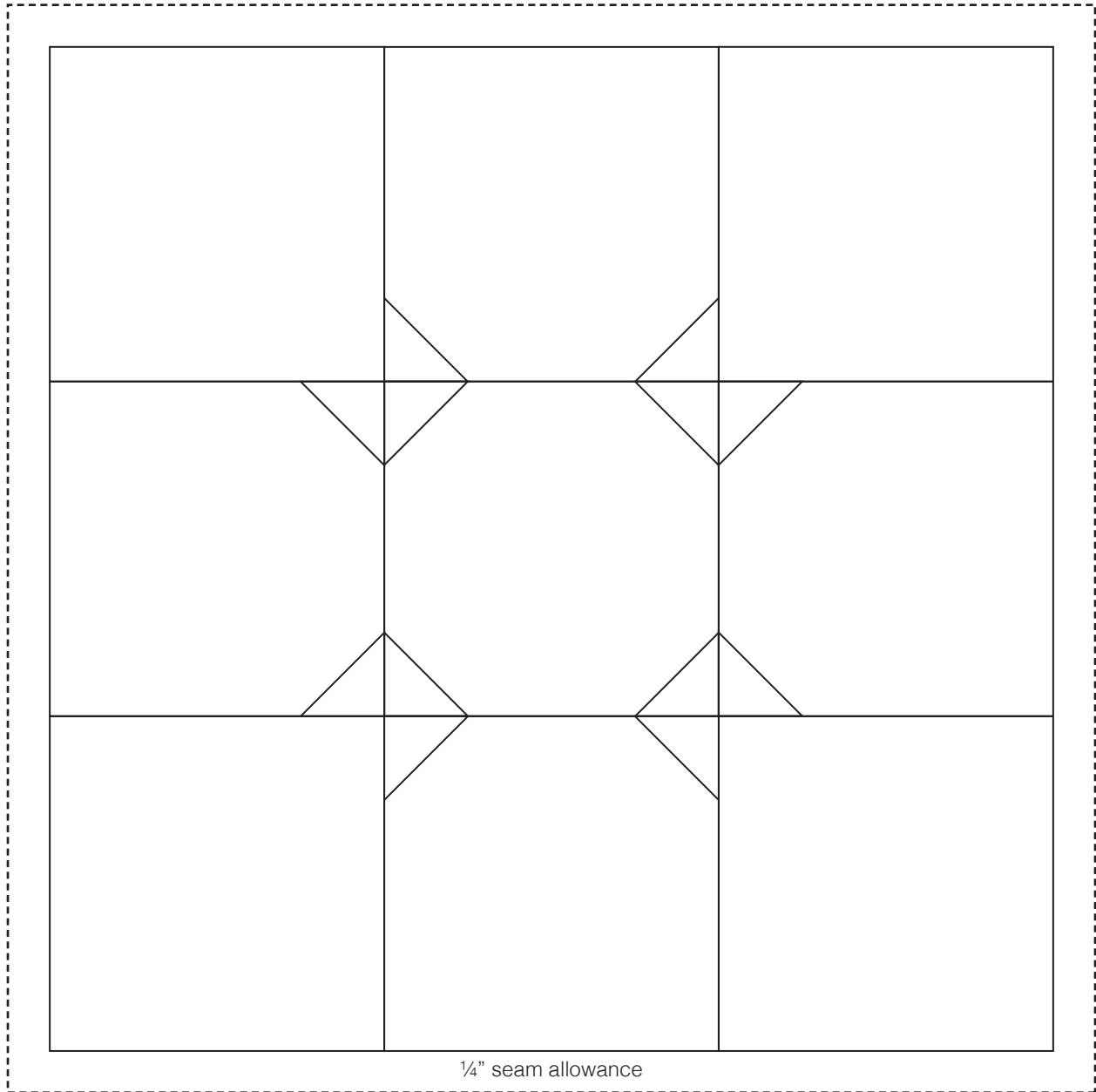
Block Assembly

1. Lay out units in 3 rows. Sew together to make rows.
2. Sew rows together.



3. Press in direction of arrows.
4. Unfinished block size 6 1/2" x 6 1/2".
